Minutes From October Membership Meeting

First Florida Chapter – MVPA

Topics – Routine Business meeting

Date: 27 October, 2018

Location: Florida Forrest Festival, Parry, FL

The meeting was called to order at 1:10pm by Chapter President Dave Thomas.

There were 15 members in attendance.

The meeting began with an opening prayer by Russell Deese.

President's Report:

1. Dave Thomas started the meeting stating it would be a short business meeting, focusing on the most pressing matters to the club. Those were: Elections, Post Fall Show and Swap report, discussion regarding conflicts within the club, Challenge Coins, and Facebook Administration. See "New Business"

Vice President:

Lindsay Orr had stated his intention to NOT seek reelection to the post. This vacancy was filled.

Secretary's Report (as before):

1. Updating the roster as new member information is received by the Secretary continues.
2. The Newsletter editor position is open. In the interim, the Secretary continues to draft the newsletter. Articles and information from members, to be included in the next issue, are always requested. Also, advertisements from members are encouraged. The newsletter is emailed to all current (paid) members and those members no more than one year behind in dues. Some members do not have or haven't provided an email address – copies are printed (black & white) and mailed to them.
3. Thus far, the Board has renewed FCC's affiliation with the national MVPA, and renewed our non-profit status and registration with the State of Florida, and requested insurance for the Winter Rally (awaiting national's renewal of the master policy)

Treasurer's Report:

1. The account balance per the end-of-September 2018 statement, was \$16,236.10. Several renewals received at the October event had been deposited, more were received during the meeting, and a couple outstanding checks incurred for the Belleview event had not been processed. As of 10 November, 2018, the balance was \$16,799.75.
2. Major expenses were the procurement of shirts and hats, and the Challenge Coins.

Area Coordinator Reports:

Northern region

1. Frank Cashman has become the new Northern Region Coordinator.
2. Jacksonville International Auto Show—The promoters want us back in 2019. In 2018, FFC was paid \$1,000.00 for attending.
3. Jacksonville Veteran's Day parade will be Monday, November 12th.
4. Plan on January 2019 meeting at Palatka Airport open house, last Saturday in January.

Central region

1. The Central Region was split into two regions, Central West and Central East, with the Lake County border with Marion and Sumter Counties forming the separation.
2. IN THE INTERIM (HINT: permanent coordinator is being sought), Dave Thomas is acting as Central West coordinator. Roger Francis has stepped up to be the Central East coordinator.

Winter Rally Coordinator:

1. Shirts have been received, 'squirrel' shirts will have logo on the front, squirrel on the back with the club's name around the squirrel.
2. Bridgett's USO show will focus this year on WWII, and will change to other periods with each Rally.
3. As in 2018, antique cars will be invited to attend.

Old Business:

1. Officer Nominations: one nomination for Vice president and three nominations for Facebook Administrators were received
2. The new Treasurer discovered that the club's IRS non-profit 501(c)10 categorization had lapsed due to failure in prior years to file the necessary IRS Form 990. In order to reinstate the club's non-profit status, the Treasurer will have to prepare the required forms and pay a \$600.00 fee to the IRS.

New Business:

1. Elections - President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Newsletter Editor - only incumbents were nominated. They were reelected.
2. Elections - Vice President - incumbent stepped down, only one nomination received, Dan Simmons of Perry, FL elected.
3. Elections - Facebook Admin. There were three nominees. The two incumbent nominees (Sean Deren and Timothy Thomas) wished to continue and were elected. (see Facebook discussion below).
4. Appointed positions - Roger Francis as Central-East region coordinator, Frank Cashman as Northern Region coordinator. Eric Leirvic will assist in the Northern region.
5. Challenge Coins - Coins with the squirrel on one side and club logo on the other, were purchased in bulk. A policy document capturing the discussions from the prior meeting was drafted read to those attending the meeting. A motion to adopt the policy was made, seconded, voted on, and approved. A copy follows these minutes in the newsletter.
6. 2019 Winter Rally - The rally will have two forms of vehicle registration. The first will be a \$20.00 fee to have a vehicle judged for an award. The fee will include a free tee shirt and guarantee that the vehicle is judged; however, it does not guarantee an award. The second will be as before, no charge for displaying a vehicle, except the vehicle will NOT be judged, and NO free tee shirt.
7. Conflicts - Without being specific, an issue arose that, HAD IT gone through, would have established a link between the club and a person or entity that would not have been in the club's best interest. This caused the Board to intervene before the club was harmed. The bad part is that the situation brewed for weeks before it came to the Board's attention, gaining some traction. As a result, the corrective action taken caused some ill will. The situation was discussed at the meeting, a draft policy to hopefully forestall future occurrences was read to the membership present. A motion to adopt the policy was made, seconded, voted on, and approved. A copy follows these minutes in the newsletter.
8. Facebook - The Facebook had been set up to allow the Officers and Regional Coordinators to have Administrative rights. Other clubs and agencies have at most two Administrators, who keep extraneous, vulgar, offensive, or other inappropriate content off the page. Going forward, members can submit something for posting, but it will first be reviewed by an Administrator. If deemed inappropriate it will be rejected, if potentially controversial, it will be forwarded to the Board for review.
9. It had been suggested by the Western Regional Coordinator to merge the Western and Southwestern regions. This was discussed and approved. The combined area will be named the "Suncoast Region". It was also suggested that the Central-East and Southeast regional Coordinators discuss splitting the Eastern region between them. They have been asked to discuss and get back to the Board with their suggestion.

FFC-MVPA Challenge Coins POLICY

With the recovery of missing funds, the organization is now able to step things up a bit. One thing suggested and voted on at the August business meeting was the design and purchase of Challenge Coins.



400 coins were ordered and received in time for the Fall Show and Swap Meet at The Markets of Marion in Belleview.

Beginning with receipt of 2019 dues (remember, we operate on a calendar year basis):

1. Renewed Paid members will receive 1 (one) coin per membership (Regular, Family or Associate).
2. Active Military (exempt from dues) will receive one coin per membership.
3. New Paid members joining on or after January 1, 2019 will receive one coin per membership.
4. Paid FFC members may purchase additional coins at \$5.00 / each.
5. Coins will be offered for sale to non-members for \$10.00 / each.

Those members who paid their 209 dues at the Show and Swap Meet received their coins.

The coins will NOT be issued every year for renewals – and skipping 2020 dues and returning in 2021 doesn't make you a "new" member.

Coins may be awarded in lieu of plaques at the Rally (i.e. Top 10) – If you renew in 2019 AND win a Top 10 at the rally, you may go home with two coins.

Additionally, as in the uniformed services, coins may be used as awards or given in gratitude for services or other support to the organization. Such awarding of coins will have to be approved by the Board. Regional Coordinators will be issued 4 (four) additional coins per year for such awards, but are cautioned to avoid being overly generous with them as once they are gone, they won't be replaced until the following year.

The decision to purchase additional coins will be made depending on the financial impact these initial 400 coins have on the organization.

FFC-MVPA Policy Interaction with Other Entities

Individual members, including the Board members and Executive Committee members, are sometimes approached by individuals representing another organization, a business, or some other entity seeking to interact with the Chapter in more than an individual membership role.

Invitations / requests to attend or participate in a function shall be brought to the attention of the Regional Coordinator, who will assist or coordinate in accordance with Article VI, Section 7 of the Bylaws. As used herein, function includes parade, show, trail ride, rally, or similar one-time event. The transfer of funds between the event organizer and any individual member that chooses to participate (.ie. reimbursement for fuel, entry fee for a show, etc.) is **STRICTLY** between the individual member and the other entity; the Chapter is not involved.

However, any such communication that involves the Chapter receiving funds or payment of funds, even if reimbursement is stated, **MUST** be presented to the Board before discussions go any further. Additionally, **ANY** offer to be a sponsor, event partner, or other arrangement in any way binding the other entity to the Chapter **MUST** be presented to the Board before engaging in further discussions.






