Meeting Minutes -First Florida Chapter –MVPA

The meeting was called to order at 1:00pm by Chapter President Dave Thomas.  
After the Pledge of Allegiance, Tim Thomas conducted the opening prayer.  
There were 18 members in attendance

President's Report:

1. Dave Thomas started the meeting long-time member Charlie Hildebrant Suffered an injuring fall and is currently in a rehab center. Contact information was available after the meeting.
2. (2nd report) The Markets of Marion has settled a suit resulting from non-member's injury that occurred during the 2017 Fall Show and Swap Meet. That individual has now claimed against the FFC, but our insurance is bushing back. There will be impacts to future events at this venue, mainly regarding overnight camping –the extent is to be determined.
3. Dave will be attending the MVPA National Reunion in York, PA; asked if others were planning to attend.
4. The MVPA HQ has taken notice of the FFC and the events we put on; so much so that they want an FFC member on the HQ board of directors. FFC members expressing interest do not have the required membership experience. However, the concept of Associate Board membership is being evaluated. **See NEW BUSINESS –MEMBER RESPONSES REQUESTED.**
5. Roger Francis did an OUTSTANDING job coordinating the Military Family appreciation event held in Kissimmee the weekend of 11 May. The event requirements were "fluid", but all issues were resolved and all members who attended had a good time. The host and sponsors were favorable impressed and stated they want us back, and the spectators enjoyed seeing our vehicles.

Vice President:

Dan Simmons reported on the October 25-26 Florida Forest Festival. FFC members are again encouraged to participate in Saturday's parade and display. Those attending will be fed Friday evening and Saturday after the parade. Secure staging is available at the Perry airport, adjacent to the festival site.  
Secretary's Report

1. The Board has renewed FCC's affiliation with the national MVPA and our non-profit status and registration with the State of Florida.
2. The Roster is continuously being updated.

Treasurer's Report:

1. The account balance per the April statement was \$17,789.24. Two checks, for design and printing of the new FFC-MVPA / WWII Armor brochure, were issued after the statement.

Area Coordinator Reports:

Northern region:

1. Frank Cashman reported there were 17 vehicles participating in the Opening of the Beaches parade in Jacksonville Beach, four jeeps were on display at the military appreciation golf tournament at the South Hampton Golf course on May 17.
2. Over the Memorial day weekend, Northern region members will be participating in a festival and parade in Palatka and a living history display at Fort Clinch.
3. The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp baseball team will be hosting a military appreciation event at the ballpark on May 30.
4. Frank pointed out the great support he has from co-coordinators Eric Leirvik and Alexander Watkins, and the quality email notices that Alexander sends out –Thanks to both.

Central-East region / website administrator:

1. The web page has had over 226,000 hits. The Facebook page is getting a lot of attention as well.
2. Members will participate in Memorial day parades in Sanford and Cocoa, FL, and an upcoming Honor Flight event.

New Business:

1. Elections -Bridget Leirvik (assistant manager of a Wells Fargo branch) was elected as Treasurer. She will soon be added to the account, and the turn-over will follow the annual audit by members, to take place at the next meeting.
2. The Westgate resort has invited the FFC and WWII Armor to utilize their 1000 acre River ranch site for some type of event. This is a result of our participation in their event in Kissimmee. Discussions will soon take place.
3. Members present approved the current Secretary / Treasurer to hire assistance as needed to get the FFC forms prepared to submit to the IRS for federal tax exempt status.

**4. See President's Report re. HQ representation. To further help the national MVPA Board amend their rules to add Associate Board Member position(s) to the Board, members are requested to send suggested justifications and / or reasons for such positions to the FFC Secretary (stantr6@comcast.net). The Secretary will gather them and compose a letter to the national proposing such a change to the bylaws. The desire is to have both FFC and WWII Armor represented.**

5. The national MVPA has taken notice of the activities taking place within the FFC, so much so that it has been suggested that we host a MVPA National Convention. Additionally, contacts were made at the Kissimmee event with Orlando area individuals that could help with sponsors. For this to take place, the involvement of more than a few members will be required. This will be a huge event, with a lot of „moving parts“ that cannot be left to only a few individuals to handle.

6. In addition to changing our IDs, the club will shop for lanyards with FFC-MVPA on them.

The meeting adjourned at approximately 2:15 p.m.

## **A Note from the Secretary / Treasurer 17 June 2019**

In the distant past, the FFC-MVPA had obtained an Employer Identification Number (EIN) from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). Since then, as I understand it, there was some form of reporting to the IRS. But, since 2011 or 2012, per the IRS, there has been no reporting. Last year, as Treasurer, I started receiving emails from companies offering to file our IRS Form 990 for us; which raised the question “What is a Form 990 ?” (It is a form non-profits must file each year)

At the March 2019 meeting, I was authorized to contact the IRS and ascertain our status. I contacted the IRS, inquired as to our status, and was told what publications to read. After reviewing those documents, I reported back at the May 2019 meeting that we had to apply for one of the tax exempt status categories. That led to more calls to the IRS and more documentation and instructions to go through. Long story short, I did so, and in consultation with the other Board members, it was agreed that we would seek a 501©3 designation. That paperwork has been prepared and submitted.

However, the research and discussions with the IRS highlighted the need to make some changes to our By-laws. Specifically, our purpose, which has been history education through the display of our vehicles, was reworded to show that as the primary objective – as per MVPA’s motto “History in Motion”. Another required change is that the Bylaws be signed by two officers.

While editing, it seemed prudent to incorporate some other “housekeeping” items; incorporating the Operations Manager position established at the March meeting, distributing proposed Bylaw changes via the newsletter, and minor tweaks to the Secretary and Treasurer positions.

The draft bylaws contained within this newsletter reflect those changes. Please forward any comments to me at stantr6@comcast.net before 31 July, 2019, or the next meeting, whichever comes first. Also Bridget Leirvic was recently elected Treasurer, the hand off will take place as soon as the annual audit by membership is completed, hopefully sometime in July.

**UPDATE: We are now officially a TAX-EXEMPT organization. On Saturday, 13 July 2019, FFC President Dave Thomas received a letter from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) granting the FFC-MVPA 501(c)3 Tax Exempt status. Our tax exempt status became effective 17 June 2019, but the notice wasn’t prepared until 5 July, and only received a few days ago.**

**Our bylaws require an inventory of FCC assets; now, so does the IRS. We have the large tent, two pop-ups, miscellaneous chairs, signage, banners, etc. in a club-owned trailer stored at Dave Thomas’ house. An external hard drive, archive records including application / renewal forms, two club banners, and a laminating machine with supplies is in Secretary Stan Kinmonth’s custody.**

## FFC-MVPA Challenge Coins POLICY

With the recovery of missing funds, the organization is now able to step things up a bit. One thing suggested and voted on at the August business meeting was the design and purchase of Challenge Coins.



SIZE: 1.75"

400 coins were ordered and received in time for the Fall Show and Swap Meet at The Markets of Marion in Belleview.

Beginning with receipt of 2019 dues (remember, we operate on a calendar year basis):

1. Renewed Paid members will receive 1 (one) coin per membership (Regular, Family or Associate).
2. Active Military (exempt from dues) will receive one coin per membership.
3. New Paid members joining on or after January 1, 2019 will receive one coin per membership.
4. Paid FFC members may purchase additional coins at \$5.00 / each.
5. Coins will be offered for sale to non-members for \$10.00 / each.

Those members who paid their 209 dues at the Show and Swap Meet received their coins.

The coins will NOT be issued every year for renewals – and skipping 2020 dues and returning in 2021 doesn't make you a "new" member.

Coins may be awarded in lieu of plaques at the Rally (i.e. Top 10) – If you renew in 2019 AND win a Top 10 at the rally, you may go home with two coins.

Additionally, as in the uniformed services, coins may be used as awards or given in gratitude for services or other support to the organization. Such awarding of coins will have to be approved by the Board. Regional Coordinators will be issued 4 (four) additional coins per year for such awards, but are cautioned to avoid being overly generous with them as once they are gone, they won't be replaced until the following year.

The decision to purchase additional coins will be made depending on the financial impact these initial 400 coins have on the organization.



## FFC-MVPA Policy Interaction with Other Entities

Individual members, including the Board members and Executive Committee members, are sometimes approached by individuals representing another organization, a business, or some other entity seeking to interact with the Chapter in more than an individual membership role.

Invitations / requests to attend or participate in a function shall be brought to the attention of the Regional Coordinator, who will assist or coordinate in accordance with Article VI, Section 7 of the Bylaws. As used herein, function includes parade, show, trail ride, rally, or similar one-time event. The transfer of funds between the event organizer and any individual member that chooses to participate (.ie. reimbursement for fuel, entry fee for a show, etc.) is STRICTLY between the individual member and the other entity; the Chapter is not involved.

However, any such communication that involves the Chapter receiving funds or payment of funds, even if reimbursement is stated, MUST be presented to the Board before discussions go any further. Additionally, ANY offer to be a sponsor, event partner, or other arrangement in any way binding the other entity to the Chapter MUST be presented to the Board before engaging in further discussions.



## FIRST FLORIDA CHAPTER MVPA REENACTORS RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

The First Florida Chapter (FFC) of the Military Vehicle Preservation Association (MVPA) sponsored events require all Reenactors to register and adhere to this code of conduct. All registered reenactors must dress in the era-appropriate attire, e.g. WWII events require WWII-era dress, Vietnam events require Vietnam-era dress, etc.

For WWII events the following WWII impressions will be allowed to take part and set up at the event:

- U.S. Army – European Theater of Operations, 1944-1945
- British/Commonwealth Army – European Theater of Operations, 1944-1945
- German Wehrmacht (Heer, Luftwaffe, SS) – Western Front, 1944-1945
- French Resistance – 1944-1945

**NON-REGISTERED REENACTORS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE EVENT. LAW ENFORCEMENT WILL BE ON SITE TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE AND TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO DO SO.**

### GENERAL RULES

#### **Registration:**

All decisions of the event coordinators and Unit Commanders are final. The Event Coordinators have the ultimate say on all matters.

All participants **MUST** be Pre-Registered by the announced registration dates. **NO WALK ONS!** Participants must present a picture ID at the check-in desk for validation of registration and be issued proof of registration (wristband, other items). Proof of registration must be carried by the participant at all times. Failure to present proof of registration will result in ejection from the event.

Individuals desiring to participate in the event must fall in with one of the Recognized Units (U.S., British/Commonwealth, German, or French Resistance) and their commanders. Attendees do NOT need to wear the Uniform and Insignia of the Recognized Units, but will be under the command of the Recognized Units. Uniform requirements will be at the discretion of the commanders of the Recognized Units.

The Recognized Units for the event and the commanders and points of contact for the same, will be announced along with the general registration announcement. At present the following Recognized Units have been approved to participate in the MVPA FFC Sponsored Events:

WW2 Armor= John Thomas-941-718-0813

41st Armored Infantry Regiment= Jim Hooks-407-595-6628

Able Company, 48th AMB= Nicki Harvey-812-774-7960

211th Panzer Grenadier Regiment= Jeff Lambert-904-408-1669

6th SS Gebirgsjager Divison= Micheal Belanger-727-686-7077

**Again, individuals and groups not on the Recognized Units list are welcome and encouraged to attend** if (a) approved by a Recognized Unit, and (b) are willing to fall in under the command and coordination of the approving Recognized Unit.

**Camp or Overnight Billeting there is any question as to how this individual conduct's, or may conduct themselves, do not sponsor him/her.**

The Event Coordinators, Property Owners, and Recognized Units may not allow other units and individuals to participate in the Events. This can be due to factors such as, but not limited to:

Unprofessional Conduct at Events or in Forums

Illegal Activities

Or any other reason deemed necessary for the sanctity of the preservation of history, the commemoration and honoring of veterans, and the safety of the reenactors and attendees

Any Individual Reenactor who wishes to attend may contact any of the Recognized Units and request Sponsorship for the event. Unit Membership is not required and subject to the decision by the Recognized Units.

The Commanders of the Recognized Units have full discretion with regards to unit membership and sponsorship of non-members, and are wholly and solely responsible for the behavior of those who fall-in under their command, members and non-members alike.

Established Recognized Units who sponsor non-member(s) re-enactors:

(a) The Sponsoring Unit is Responsible for the Individual being sponsored in regards to:

Behavior During & After the Event on Event Grounds

Camp or Overnight Billeting

Individual's Proper Uniform & Equipment

Individual's Conduct during the battle

**NOTE: If there is any question as to how this individual conduct's, or may conduct themselves, do not sponsor him/her.**

## **GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT FOR EVENT**

**NO ILLEGAL ACTIVITY IS CONDONED OR PERMITTED, ALL CRIMINAL ACTIVITY WILL BE REPORTED TO THE POLICE, AND BOTH CIVIL AND CRIMINAL PROSECUTION WILL BE PURSUED. NO EXECPTIONS, NO WARNINGS. COMMIT A CRIME AND YOU WILL BE ARRESTED.**

**NO LIVE AMMUNITION AT THE EVENT**

ALL WEAPONS AND BLANKS WILL BE SAFETY CHECKED EVERY MORNING BY THE RECOGNIZED UNIT COMMANDERS OR THEIR DESIGNEES. THE EVENT COORDINATORS WILL BE ADVISED OF THIS DAILY. THOSE WHO FAIL THE WEAPON SAFETY CHECK, OR FAIL TO ATTEND, WILL BE FORBIDDEN FROM EVENT PARTICIPATION AND MAY BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE EVENT.

AUTHENTICITY CHECKS AT THE SAME TIME AS WEAPONS FOR PROPER UNIFORM, SHAVE, AND HAIRCUT. THOSE WHO FAIL THE AUTHENTICITY CHECK WILL BE FORBIDDEN FROM EVENT PARTICIPATION AND MAY BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE EVENT.

TENTS SET UP IN THE DISPLAY, AND BATTLE AREA, MUST MAINTAIN THE AUTHENTICITY OF THE ERA BEING REPRESENTED. NO MODERN CAMPING/VEHICLES MIXED IN WITH THE ERA DISPLAY.

NO MODERN VEHICLES IN THE DISPLAY AREA DURING EVENT HOURS.

NO WEAPONS TESTING EXCEPT IN THE DESIGNATED WEAPONS TESTING AREA, PRECEDED BY YELLING **“FIRE IN THE HOLE!”**, NO INDIVIDUAL TESTING OF WEAPONS – ALWAYS HAVE A BATTLE BUDDY/SAFETY OBSERVER.

ALL WEAPONS TESTING MUST BE APPROVED BY THE EVENT COORDINATOR. NO FIRING AT NIGHT UNLESS SPECIFICALLY APPROVED BY THE EVENT COORDINATOR.

NO PYROTECHNIC DEVICES ARE PERMITTED, UNLESS APPROVED BY AN EVENT COORDINATOR PRIOR TO THE EVENT.

NO WEAPONS OR DEVICES THAT FIRE A PROJECTILE ARE PERMITTED.

NO LOADED FIREARMS EXCEPT DURING BATTLES, WEAPONS DEMOS, OR WEAPONS TESTING. ONLY BLANK AMMUNITION TO BE USED WHEN WEAPONS ARE LOADED.

“KILL, KILL, KILL” IS THE REAL-WORLD EMERGENCY SAFETY PHRASE.

REENACTORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18, BUT AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE, WILL BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE, BUT ONLY UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A PARENT OR ADULT OF AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE FOR THE ENTIRETY OF THE EVENT. A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST SIGN THE APPROPRIATE PERMISSIONS


PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO KEEP THE CAMP AREA CLEAN OF GARBAGE, MODERN ITEMS SUCH AS WATER BOTTLES, COOLERS, ETC.

NO DISRESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR WILL BE TOLERATED. VIOLATORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE EVENT AND WILL BE BANNED FROM FUTURE EVENTS.

UNIT COMMANDERS AND REGISTERED UNITS WILL BE HELD LIABLE FOR THE ACTIONS OF THEIR MEMBERS AND NON-MEMBERS UNDER THEIR COMMAND. POLICE YOURSELVES ACCORDINGLY.

THE STANDARDS OF ADULT BEHAVIOR APPLIES TO BOTH INDIVIDUALS AND UNITS, AND APPLIES AT EVENTS AS WELL AS PUBLIC FORUMS SUCH AS PUBLIC SOCIAL MEDIA POSTS. VIOLATION OF THESE RULES, PER-EVENT RULES, OR THE STANDARDS OF DECENCY, CIVILITY, AND PROFESSIONALISM WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE EJECTION FROM THE EVENT AND A BAN ON ATTENDANCE AT ALL FUTURE EVENTS. AN EVENT BAN WILL BE REPORTED TO ALL KNOWN EVENT COORDINATORS OF ALL EVENTS IN THE U.S. WE WILL HONOR THE EVENT BANS ISSUED BY ALL KNOWN EVENT COORDINATORS OF ALL EVENTS IN THE U.S.



The Military Museum of North Florida is located, is the former Naval Air Station, Green Cove Springs, Benjamin Lee Field. The base was the main training base for the F6F Hellcat fighter which had over 5000 shoot-downs in WWII. It was the US Navy's main Zero killer. Visitors can walk in the shadows of WWII fighter pilots and heroes to include General Roy Geiger, the father of Marine Corps aviation, the Black Sheep Squadron pilots, and many more. The Military Museum of North Florida honors ALL service men and women from EVERY branch of the service. There are pictures and displays of uniforms, weapons and equipment from each of our major conflicts. You can see what it must have been like to live on the western front in World War I. The equipment and photos from the Vietnam War show how far warfare had progressed since WWI. There are examples of vehicles from the Korean era through Vietnam and beyond. The museum has many special events including displays of military art like these from noted artist John Shaw. Among other events are our Military History Day, D-Day Commemoration, National Holidays


